### Medicaid Self-Care *Health at Home*® Research Studies

#### Evaluation Time Period – 6 months N = 4,819

- 51% of citizens stated the guide enabled them to avoid one or more visits to the doctor. This amounted to a reduction of 2,457 visits and produced a savings of \$238,378 (based on an average visit cost of \$97.)
- 45% of the citizens stated the guide prevented one or more visits to the emergency room. This amounted to a reduction of 2,168 visits and produced a savings of \$607,040 (based on an average E.R. visit cost of \$280).
- The total savings was \$845,418 or a savings of \$175.43 per person.
- 18% of the citizens stated the guide helped them avoid one or more sick days from work.
- 85% of the citizens stated they would recommend the **Health at Home**® guide to others.

#### Evaluation Time Period – 6 months N = 1,360

#### COST EFFECTIVENESS RESULTS:

- 48% of citizens stated the guide enabled them to avoid one or more visits to the doctor. This amount to a reduction of 652 doctor visits and produced a savings of \$63,334 (based upon an average visit cost of \$97).
- 42% of the citizens stated the guide prevented one or more emergency room visits. This amounted to a reduction of 571 visits and produced a savings of \$45,680 (based upon an average visit cost of \$280).
- The total savings was \$109,014 or \$80.16 per citizen.
- 17% of the citizens stated the guide helped them avoid one or more sick days from work.
- 84% of the citizens stated they would recommend the **Health at Home**® guide to others.
